
Tees Barrage International White Water Centre is a purpose-built watersports facility found in stunning surroundings on the banks of the River Tees in Stockton-on-Tees.







Storm City is centered on an ultimate man versus nature experiment. Using advanced engineering technology and science, a team of experts set out to recreate the impact of natural forces to investigate what the effects are.

Filmed on a mix of real-world locations and sets in both Canada and the UK, the team simulated what happens during earthquakes, extreme winds, avalanches and floods. Cameras were fitted to a purpose built two-storey house as weather conditions are reconstructed and tests carried out to fully demonstrate the catastrophic damage that extreme natural forces can cause.



During the flooding sequences, people are caught in fast-moving, dangerous water – from drivers becoming stuck in cars to a baby being swept away. "It was very impressive," said Pedrom Dadgostar, 3D supervisor. "They had dressed a section to look more like the village location, including a bridge, and had complete control over how much water would flow along the course. Having that capability is crucial for maintaining safety on set, but also in getting otherwise impossible shots. Facilities like this are important for filmmaking because they give directors the ability to convey those dramatic moments without putting actors at risk."



In what was dubbed 'Emmerdale's biggest stunt', the actors from the ITV soap descended on Tees Barrage to film the highly anticipated waterfall scene as part of 'Survival Week'.

The stunt involved the cast plummeting down a waterfall following a bridge collapse that saw Manpreet Sharma and Charles Anderson plunge into the raging river below, while Victoria Sugden and David Metcalfe clung to the hanging bridge.

The bridge was erected fully over the White Water Course and the highly trained staff were on hand to assist the actors and ensure a safe environment.




