



Durham Cathedral

Durham Cathedral is a magnificent Norman structure and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Originally a monastic church, it is regarded as one of the finest examples of Norman architecture in Europe. The cathedral stands on a hill with a green in front of it, and features an early rib-vaulted nave, towering stone pillars, intricate galleries, and impressive spiral staircases. Visitors can climb its 218-foot-high tower for breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape.
