



North and South Bailey

North Bailey and South Bailey are the two historic streets that together make up *The Bailey* – one of the most distinctive and oldest parts of Durham City, lying within the sharp meander of the River Wear and forming part of the medieval city's core. The Bailey area is part of Durham Castle and Cathedral UNESCO World Heritage Site and showcases a remarkable range of historic buildings from different eras, from medieval to Georgian and later.
