Alnwick is a historic market town in Northumberland, England, located about 35 miles (56 km) north of Newcastle upon Tyne. Set on the south bank of the River Aln, the town blends medieval heritage with vibrant tourism and countryside charm. Surrounded by rolling Northumbrian landscapes and close to the North Sea coast, Alnwick is known for its cobbled streets, traditional stone buildings, and strong sense of history. Its position makes it a gateway to Northumberland's castles, coastline, and national park. Alnwick's combination of medieval architecture, literary charm, and cinematic fame makes it one of Northumberland's most distinctive and visited towns.
