



## **Berwick Upon Tweed**

Berwick-upon-Tweed is a historic market town in Northumberland, England, located at the northernmost tip of England near the Scottish border.

Sitting at the mouth of the River Tweed, it has changed hands multiple times between England and Scotland over the centuries, giving it a rich and sometimes turbulent history. Today, it's known for its well-preserved Elizabethan town walls – some of the finest in Europe – and its distinctive red-brick Georgian architecture.

Berwick is also famous for its three bridges spanning the River Tweed, including the iconic Royal Border Bridge designed by Robert Stephenson. With a population of around 12,000, it's a small but culturally vibrant town, blending English and Scottish influences in its traditions, accent, and identity.
